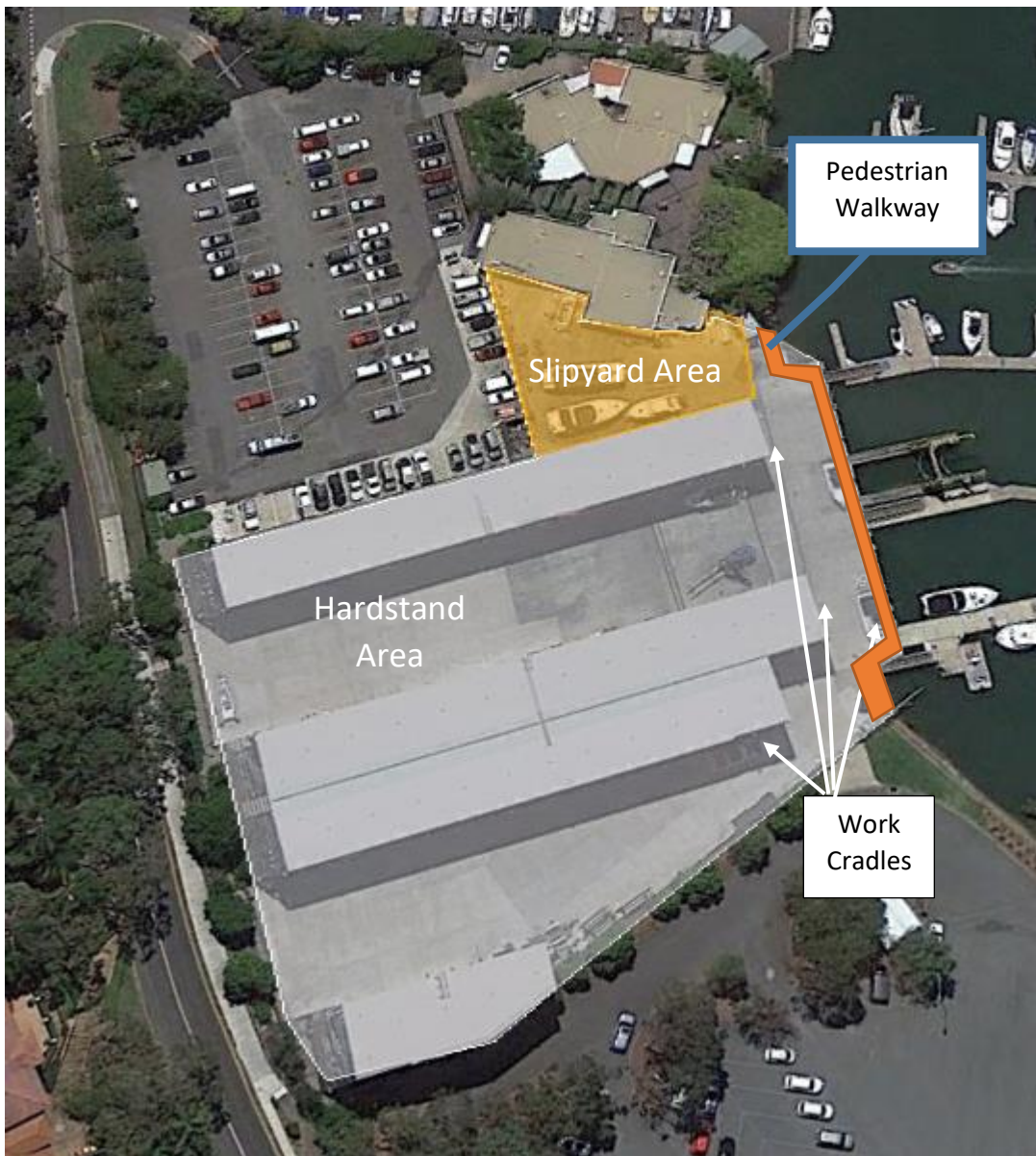


RULES FOR THE EAST COAST MARINA HARDSTAND & SLIPYARD (Yard)

1. All vessels coming to East Coast Marina, regardless of method of delivery, must be booked in advance with the Marina Office
1. On entering upon the Yard area all persons are to comply with all directions given by ECM Staff.
2. Personnel in the Yard are not to approach machine operators while machine is operating.
3. Pedestrian access to launching piers is only permitted using the designated walkway via the shoreside pedestrian gates.
4. There is No After-Hours access to the Yard unless authorised by the Marina Office.
5. The Southern Gate is to remain locked at all times except where ECM staff deem it necessary to open for access.
6. All persons moving about the Yard area are always to wear HIVIZ vest or clothing and closed in shoes.
7. Only personnel authorised by the Marina Office are permitted in the Yard . All visitors, clients, friends or contractors must register at the Office; supplying contact details, and if applicable a description of work to be undertaken, evidence of current insurance and to collect a HIVIZ vest. On completion of work they must present themselves to the Office to return vest and sign out .
8. Any unauthorised personnel in the Yard may be directed by ECM Staff to leave the area immediately.
9. All work requests are to be made at the Marina Office, not to hardstand staff. East Coast Marina reserves their right to impose service, storage and cleaning charges and an environmental levy. Please refer to current price list for details.
10. The Yard staff are to be supplied daily with a list of personnel who have authority to be in the Yard and the purpose of that attendance.
11. No work is to be undertaken by any contractor or client on boats stored on the ground level in the Rack Storage area without authorisation from ECM Marina Office. Only minor works such as measurement taking and machinery inspections will be permitted. Wherever work outside the vessel is to be performed the work area is to be cordoned under the direction of the machine operator so that the area is clearly visible to machine operators.
12. Only minor works are permitted on the Hardstand Work Cradles area e.g. Detailing & Engine servicing. No sanding, grinding, or cutting without the use of dust extraction and collection equipment will be permitted. Outside contractors using work cradles are not to display advertising signage.
13. Hardstand work cradle bookings: - maximum duration one workday (0800-1600 hrs). Charges apply.
14. No persons are permitted in the Yard area when the Yard staff have ceased operations.
15. The Yard is a No-smoking area and Yard staff may direct people to stop smoking if detected.

16. Consumption of alcohol is forbidden by any personnel when working in the Yard Area.
